

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of May 4, 2011.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 7:00 P.M. on May 4, 2011.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Trager, Commissioners Davis, Hollenbeck, O'Brien and Buckingham. Absent None.

Moved by Commissioner Buckingham, seconded by Commissioner Hollenbeck that the minutes from the Council meeting of April 20, 2011 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioners Davis, Hollenbeck, O'Brien Buckingham, Mayor Trager. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Davis seconded by Commissioner Hollenbeck that the accounts payable for the last half of April 2011 in the amount of \$67,275.64 be approved and warrants be drawn on the City Treasury for the several amounts. Moved by Mayor Trager and seconded by Commissioner Hollenbeck That Ordinance 1440, An Ordinance amending the Liquor Control Ordinance be adopted. Ayes; Commissioner Davis, Hollenbeck, Buckingham and Mayor Trager. Nays: Commissioner O'Brien .

Moved by Mayor Trager and seconded by Commissioner Hollenbeck that a Class A Liquor License be issued to Joseph Coon D/B/A DUECES 351 Main St. for the fiscal year 2011-2012 Ayes; Commissioner Davis, Hollenbeck, Buckingham and Mayor Trager. Nays: Commissioner O'Brien.
